



Grading System for Graduate of Nankai University

1. Grading Methods

Nankai University adopts three grading methods: Percentage System, Descriptions, and Grades. Only passing grades are eligible for earning the credit. Details are as follows:

- (1) Percentage System: 60 points and above are qualified for earning the credit
- (2) Descriptions: Pass or Fail. "Pass" indicates eligibility.
- (3) Grades: Four levels - "A," "B," "C," "D." "A," "B," "C" are passing grades. The correspondence between the grading system and percentage grades is as follows:

Grades	Percentage System	Descriptions
A	85~100	Pass
B	75~84	Pass
C	60~74	Pass
D	< 60	Fail

2. Average Credit Grade

Credit grade for a course = Percentage course score \times Credit points

Average credit grade = \sum Credits obtained in percentage-based courses / \sum Credits obtained

Credit grades are kept to two decimal places.
